





Sri Guru Amar Das Ji obtained the complete happiness of Sri Guru Angad Dev Ji by performing selfless service for 12 years. A famous Sakhi indicates Guru Sahib's love for fulfilling their daily seva of bringing water for Sri Guru Angad Dev Ji's Ishnaan from River Beas. In the dark, when Guru Sahib's Charan hit a weaver's peg lying on the floor, their body lost balance, but they did not let the water pitcher fall. Pleased with this selfless service, Sri Guru Angad Dev Ji gave 12 boons to Sri Guru Amar Das Ji, such as 'Nimaania de Maan, Nitaania de Taan' (honour of the meek, power of the helpless). The divine Joth of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji was passed on from Sri Guru Angad Dev Ji to Sri Guru Amar Das Ji in 1552 C.E.



Sri Guru Ram Das Ji took Parkash in Chuna Mandi, Lahore in 1534 C.E. After joining the Sangat of Sri Guru Amar Das Ji in Goindwal Sahib at a young age, Sri Guru Ram Das Ji devoted their mind and body to selfless service. Kavi Santokh Singh Ji records one such instance of Guru Ji's seva. One day Sri Guru Amar Das Ji asked their Sevak Bhai Ballu that it had been many days since they had seen Sri Guru Ram Das Ji. Bhai Ballu Ji said, 'he is engaged in the service of the Sangat day and night, he prepares langar and serves it to the Sangat. He fetches cold water from the well, serving it to the thirsty. Whatever the Sikhs request, he fulfills their desire. Then he stands and waves the fan over the Sangat.' Hearing this, Sri Guru Amar Das Ji said, 'Ram Das Hai Dhan', 'blessed is Ram Das'.



The most famous and sacred spot of Goindwal Sahib is Gurdwara Sri Baoli Sahib. A Baoli (step well), paved with 84 steps was constructed here. In Gurpartap Suraj Granth, Kavi Santokh Singh Ji has recorded the words of Sri Guru Amar Das Ji during the time of the Bauli Sahib being constructed:

> 'Baar Chaurasi Kar Snaan. Itneh Japuji Paath Bakhaan. Satgur Moorat Karke Dhiaan. Mitteh Chaurasi Aavan Jaan.'

That individual who bathes 84 times in this Bauli and recites the same number of Japuji Sahib (one per step), those who complete this with their focus on the form of the Satguru, their coming and going in the 8.4 million lifeforms shall be destroyed.





When Sri Guru Arjan Dev Ji were of a young age they were playing and went into Sri Guru Amar Das Ji's room while they were resting. Bibi Bhani Ji rushed to pick up Sri Guru Arjan Dev Ji, however, Sri Guru Amar Das Ji instructed her not to. Sri Guru Amar Das Ji picked up their grandson and feeling the heavy weight remarked, 'he shall be a great Guru in this world. He shall be the great Ship of Gurbani, who will ferry the whole world across (Baani Ke Bohith)'. With these prophetic words, Sri Guru Amar Das Ji foretold the great task their grandson would undertake, the compilation of Sri Aadh Guru Granth Sahib Ji.



Sri Guru Amar Das Ji's elder daughter (Bibi Dani Ji) was married to Bhai Rama Ji, who performed great seva in the Sangat. One day the sangat asked Sri Guru Amar Das Ji, 'Guru Ji! Both your sons-in-law are your areatest sevaks. Who is the most pleasing to you?' To give the sangat the answer, Guru Ji instructed both Bhai Rama Ji and Sri Guru Ram Das Ji to create a brick platform each according to certain specifications. After both had constructed their platforms, Guru Ji inspected them and giving disapproval, instructed them to build the platforms again. For three consecutive days, Guru Ji asked them both to rebuild the platforms. On the third day, Bhai Rama refused, claiming his platform to be perfect. Sri Guru Ram Das Ji humbly fell at Guru Ji's feet asking for forgiveness and asked for the correct guidance to make a platform pleasing to the Guru. Guru Ji was pleased with Sri Guru Ram Das Ji and gave many words of praise. In this manner, Guru Ji eradicated any doubts in the minds of the Sikhs and showed that Sri Guru Ram Das Ji was the deserving beneficiary of the Gurgadhi.



ਮੁੱਘਰ Maghar

On Bhadron Sudi 13, 1631 Bikrami (1574 C.E.), Sri Guru Amar Das Ji bestowed the Gurgadhi to Sri Guru Ram Das Ji, two days prior to their Joth Joth. Sri Guru Amar Das Ji instructed the Rababis to sing Kirtan and their sevak Bhai Ballu Ji to dress Sri Guru Ram Das Ji in new clothes. Holding Sri Guru Ram Das Ji by their arm, Sri Guru Amar Das Ji sat them upon their own throne. As per the tradition of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji, the Tilak (saffron mark) was placed on the forehead of Sri Guru Ram Das Ji. Sri Guru Amar Das Ji bowed to Sri Guru Ram Das Ji and then instructed their family to do the same. Bhai Mohri Ji, the younger son of Sri Guru Amar Das Ji was the first to bow to Sri Guru Ram Das Ji. The spot where the Gurgadhi was bestowed is marked by a gold engraving depicting this scene, in Gurdwara Chaubara Sahib, Goindwal Sahib.

On Ang 923 of Sri Guru Granth Sahib Ji is the Ramkali Sadh, penned by Baba Sundar Ji, the great grandson of Sri Guru Amar Das Ji. This Baani records the final Updesh (teachings) of Sri Guru Amar Das Ji to the Sangat and the Gurgadhi of Sri Guru Ram Das Ji. Sadh means 'call', the call of departing this world, that befalls all. Guru Sahib gave the teaching of accepting the will of Akaal Purakh, and only Naam is our help and support at the final moment. Guru Sahib, summoning their family, gave them the wisdom that they are not to cry after they depart, such actions would not please them at all. Instead, Guru Ji instructed them to do continuous Kirtan and Katha after they depart. Finally, Baba Sundar Ji records how Guru Sahib enthrones Sri Guru Ram Das Ji on the Gurgadhi, infusing in them the Joth (divine light) of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji.

These include the Pavithar Kesh (hair), and Chola Sahib (tunic) preserved at Gurdwara Sri Chaubara Sahib (Sri Goindwal Sahib). Here also is the Killi Sahib (wooden peg) Guru Sahib would hold onto in their later years in remembrance of Akaal Purakh. One of Sri Guru Amar Das Ji's shoes encased in silver (the original shoe sits inside the silver case) is preserved by a family formerly from Shekhupura (now Pakistan).



On Bhadron Sudi Puranmashi, 1631 Bikrami (1574 C.E.), after giving their final instructions to the Saadhsangat to accept Vaheguru Ji's will as sweet, Sri Guru Amar Das Ji lay down, and after placing a white sheet over their body they departed from their mortal frame. At the time all the Sangat of Goindwal exclaimed 'Dhan Dhan Satguru', while the celestial beings exclaimed 'Jai Jai Kaar'. Sri Guru Ram Das Ji, Baba Mohari Ji, Baba Budha Ji, Bhai Ballu Ji performed the Ishnaan Seva of Guru Ji's sacred body. Guru Ji was placed on a palanquin while the sangat blew conch shells, showered flower petals, and sang Gurbani. Guru Ji was taken to the riverbank of Beas and cremated on a pyre of sandalwood. Guru Ji's complete age was 105 years, 4 months and 1 day.
