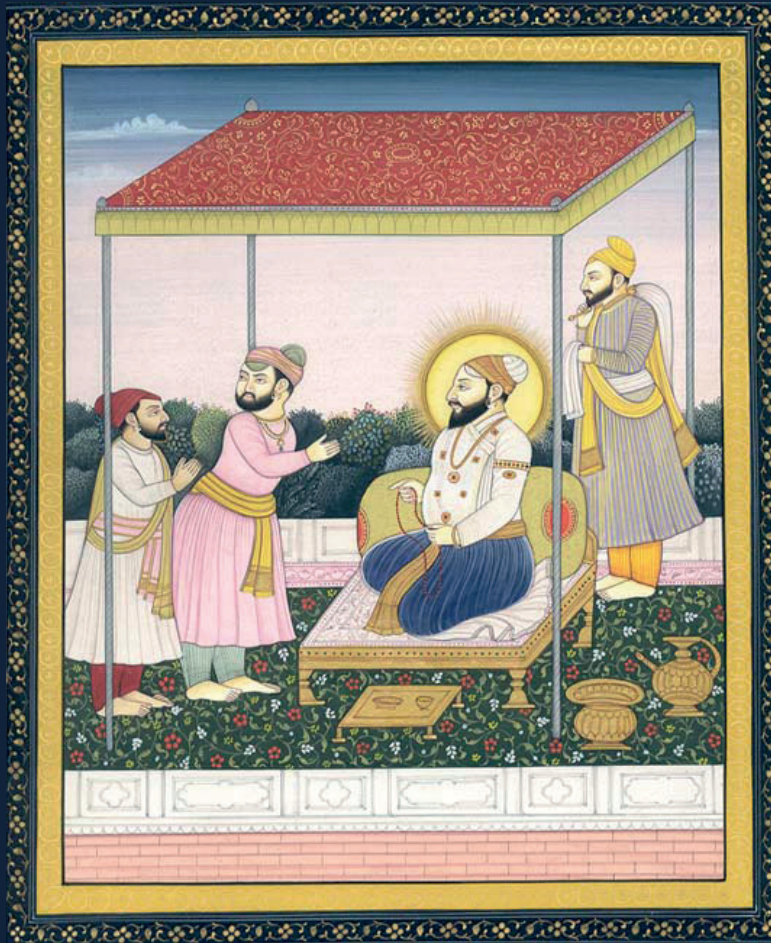

GURU HAR RAI SAHIB JI

2nd CHETH/ 15th MARCH

Guru Har Rai Sahib Ji received Guruship in 1695 Bikrami (1638 AD). Despite not engaging in battle, they maintained an army of Saint Soldiers in the same way their grandfather Guru Hargobind Sahib Ji did. When their son Ram Rai distorted Gurbani to please the Mughal Emperor, Maharaj banished him from the Sikh Panth.

1st VAISAKH/ 14th APRIL

In 1756 Bikrami (1699 AD) Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji manifested the Khalsa Panth at Sri Kesgarh Sahib, Anandpur Sahib. Five beloved Sikhs passed Guru Ji's ultimate test of faith by offering their heads. Guru Ji prepared Khande Batteh Da Amrit (Nectar of the double edged sword) and initiated them as the first members of the Khalsa Panth. Afterwards, Guru Ji in humility asked to be blessed with the same gift of Amrit from them, investing the power of the Guru into the Panj Piare.

OPERATION BLUE STAR

19th - 24th JETH/ 1st - 6th JUNE

In 1984 countless Sikhs were made Shaheed by the Indian Army while defending the sanctity of Sri Darbar Sahib Amritsar. Sant Giani Jarnail Singh Ji Khalsa Bhindranwale and a handful of Singhs defended the house of Guru Ramdas Ji from the might of the vast Indian Army. Thousands of innocent women, children and elderly who had come to commemorate Sri Guru Arjan Dev Ji's Shaheedi Purab were mercilessly killed by the Indian Army. Sikh Heritage including hundreds of Historic handwritten Saroops and artefacts were destroyed/stolen, never to be returned.

GURU ARJAN DEV JI

3rd HARR/ 17th JUNE

In 1663 Bikrami (1606 AD) Sri Guru Arjan Dev Ji, accepting Vaheguru's will as sweet, gave Shaheedi (martyrdom). Even while facing various tortures including being sat on a hot iron plate while boiling hot sand was poured over their head, Guru Ji uttered the line 'Tera Keeya Meetha Laage' (Vaheguru, your will is sweet to me.) Guru Ji became Shaheed after taking ishnaan in the Ravi River and reciting Sri Jap Ji Sahib. On this spot now stands Gurdwara Sri Dehra Sahib, Lahore.

22nd SAAVAN/ 6th AUGUST

In 1713 Bikrami (1656 AD) the Eighth Master, Sri Guru Harkrishan Sahib ji took form in this world. Guru Harkrishan Sahib became Guru at the young age of five and continued to spread the message of Sikhi until they left their body in 1721 Bikrami (1664 AD). They spent some of this time tending to sufferers of smallpox and cholera, after which they too took this illness upon themselves and left their body, accepting the will of Vaheguru.

Guru Arjan Dev ji from this point reiterated the importance of keeping utmost respect for Gurbani to the Sangat by always sitting at a lower level to Sri Aadh Granth Sahib ji.

Celebrating the triumph of good over evil, Dusherra commemorates the time when Sri Ram Chandar destroyed Ravan. Typically celebrated by the Hindu faith by performing plays for nine nights; Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji changed this to reading Judh Mai Bani. Changing this festival to focus on Shastar (weapon) and Shaastar (scripture), Guru Sahib instilled Chardi Kala into his Sikhs.
